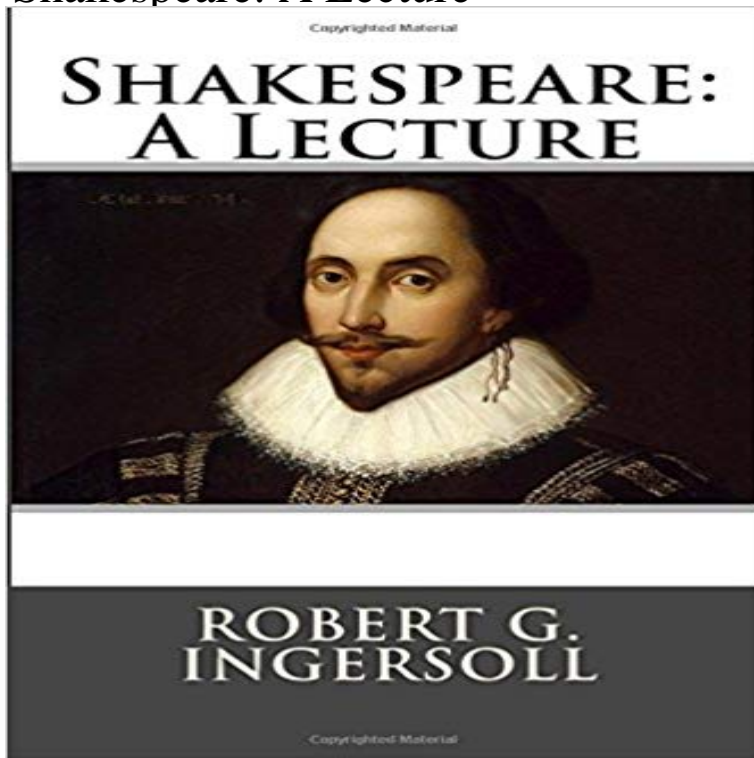


Shakespeare: A Lecture
