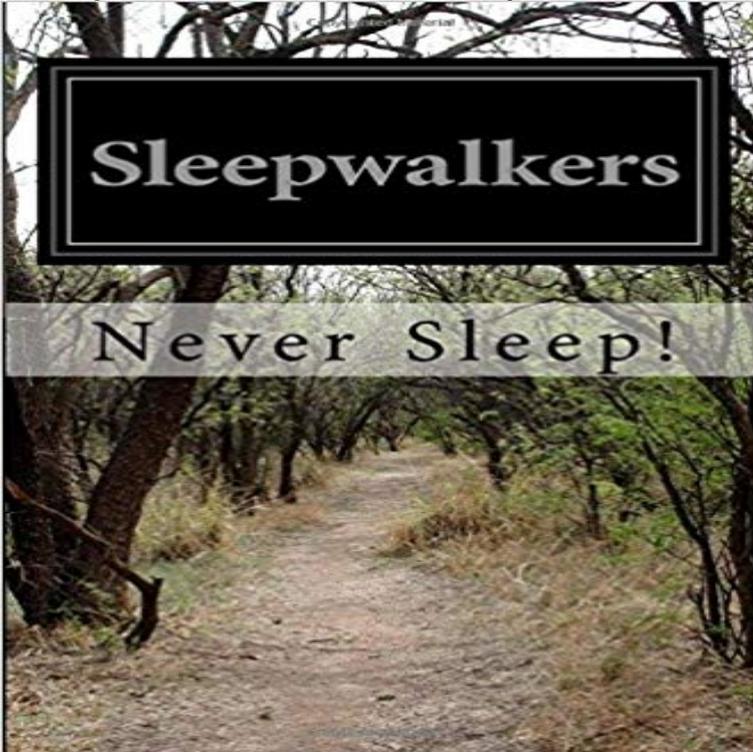


Sleepwalkers: Never Sleep!
