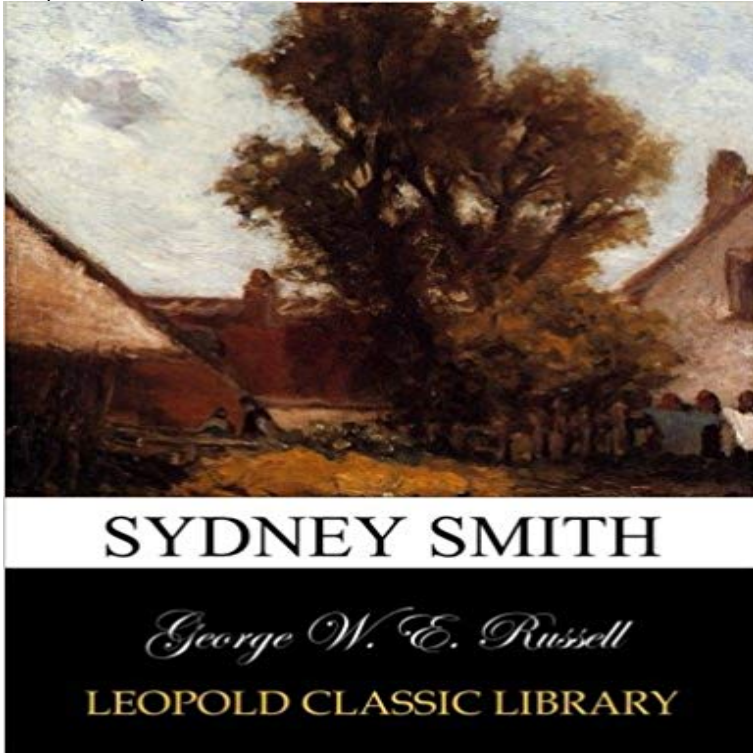


## Sydney Smith
