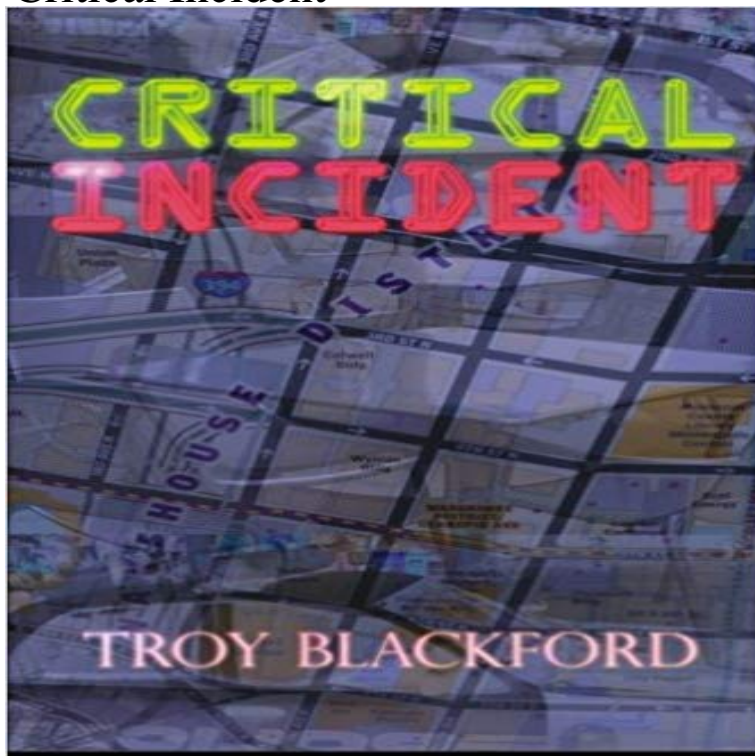


Critical Incident
