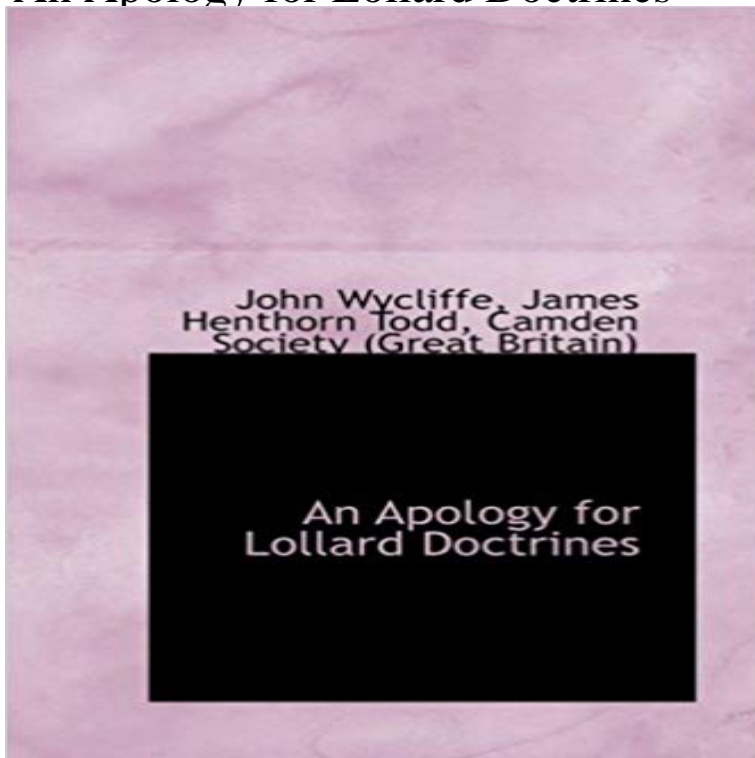


An Apology for Lollard Doctrines
